

## **SSYC Adult Sailing Program** 2024 Class Schedule and Prices

Program runs June 8 - July 31

Weekly classes held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Saturdays

<b>Novice Sailors</b>	Novice sailors with little or no sailing experience will receive instruction and sailing experience in the fundamentals of safety, rigging, launching, steering, sail handling, sailing upwind and downwind, tacking and jibing and docking. Students require some physical agility for small boat sailing. Students will prac- tice these skills on at the water in small boats with instruction from experi- enced sailors.
Intermediate Sailors	Students get instruction tailored to their needs to develop and build upon their sailing skills. More experienced sailors will be introduced to the finer points of sail trim, including understanding sail shape for various wind conditions and sea states. Crew weight and boat balance for optimal performance in various conditions. Students will practice coordination of helm and sheet, recognizing wind shifts, gusts and lulls and reacting to these changes. Students require sufficient physical agility for small boat sailing, as they will practice these skills on the water in small boats with instruction from experienced instructors.
